

Literacy Standards

For Preschool

Listening and Speaking

- Participates appropriately in conversation
 - *Listens to speaker
 - *Waits their turn to talk
 - *Responses are accurate and relevant
- Speaks in simple sentences
 - *Speaks in sentences with a five word minimum
- Uses descriptive and comparative words
 - *Can describe one object and compare it to another object

Concepts of Print

- Demonstrates an understanding of concepts of print
 - *Understands left to right, top and bottom of book, front and back of book

Phonics

- Recognizes at least 10 alphabet letters
 - *Can name any alphabet letters, upper and or lower case
- Understands that alphabet letters represent sounds
 - *Hears beginning sounds, minimum correct 3 out of 4

Writing

- Writes for meaning
 - *Writes to express ideas, using scribbles, letters
 - *Reads own writing
 - *Dictates stories

Math Standards

For Preschool

Counting Skills

- Recites numbers in order from 1-10
- Models one to one correspondence up to 5
 - *Point and count objects correctly
 - *Match equivalent set of objects (dominoes)
 - *Creates group of 5 objects and hands to teacher
- Compares sets to determine more or less
 - *Compares sets to 5 (which one has more/less)

Sorting

- Sorts by one attribute
 - *Sort by 1 attribute, color and or size

Geometry

- Identifies 4 basic shapes
*Identify circle, square, triangle and rectangle
 - Puts together a simple puzzle
*Puts together a puzzle with 6-12 pieces

Fine Motor Coordination

- Uses correct pencil grip
*Holds pencils and other writing materials correctly (using one of the two approved grips)
 - Uses scissors correctly
*Correct scissors grip
*Can cut a simple triangle and circle
 - Buttons/zips own coat
*Can button or zip up their own coat

Large Motor Coordination

- Exhibits large motor coordination
*Includes: Ball skills (kick, catch, throw), Balance beam, Balance 1 foot and then the other, Hop (2feet), Hop (1 foot)

*Wash hands with soap and warm water, use a tissue, toiletry skills
