Kindergarten Registration will be held on Tuesday, February 23, 2010, from 9:30 – 10:30 in the auditorium for all students who will be attending kindergarten at Mount Mahogany next year. Students must live within Mount Mahogany School boundaries to register. Children do not need to come with you to register.

A child must be five on or before September 1, 2010, in order to attend kindergarten in the fall. This is a state law and no exceptions can be made. A birth certificate and record of immunizations are required to complete the registration procedure.

If you are not the birth or adoptive parent of the child you are registering, you must provide court documentation, at the time of registration, stating that you have ***legal guardianship***.

Also, if you are not currently married to the child's other biological parent, you must provide court documentation, which states you have ***physical legal custody*** before the child can be enrolled.

We would appreciate it if you would share this information with neighbors whose oldest child would qualify for kindergarten next year.

We look forward to meeting with you on February 23. If you are unable to attend that day please contact the school.
